Several of our members will be participating in a SCDOT sponsored "Symposium" in September where we may highlight the educational opportunities of the IRWA and again hopefully add some members. A "blue ribbon panel" has been appointed to investigate and update our Website. More to come on this.



Bill Christian proposed for business at the next meeting a bylaw change to conduct business electronically or over the phone as opposed to waiting for quarterly meetings. (More on this on page **5**, **top right**)

Summer Seminar—Social networking location will be at Foothills Brewing Company in downtown Winston-Salem on Thursday evening, August 23, 2012. Hampton Inn at Summit Square in Winston-Salem will be the host hotel. Look for the hotel information in the newsletter later this month.

Winter Seminar will be held in Charleston, SC on October 19th. Hotel information is forthcoming. Education classes will be held prior to the quarterly meeting and will be announced in the newsletter.

SCDOT Symposium—IRWA Chapter 31 members will conduct 8 hours of presentations for the symposium over 2 days. Bill Christian, Angel Banks, Frank Mundy and Bob Merryman from OR Colon will be speakers on behalf of the chapter. Presentations will be broken into four, two hour sessions on September 19th and 20th.

NCDOT Training—Working on memorandum of understanding to support major training initiative with Florence Greene of NCDOT. It involves over 450 employees and potentially over 30 classroom sessions supported by International. Our chapter will receive an honorarium for each participant and receive a \$30 membership fee from each participant that attends at least four training sessions. There will be some administration on our part but very minimal. Bill Christian will sign the memorandum of understanding on behalf of the chapter.

Website—we would like to develop a new website to have a link to International and a link from International's website to our website. Possible ideas for our website would be for it to have the capability to register for quarterly seminars, easy to update and user friendly. Frank Mundy to investigate securing an entity to design the website.

Membership--International set a membership goal of 5% growth for our chapter, with the potential participation from the local DOT's we have the potential to easily surpass 5% growth for the year and potentially become the largest chapter in Region 6.
